

## ADDENDUM: AIR TRANSPORTATION TERMS & CONDITIONS

Effective Date: January 9, 2026

This Addendum applies to all air arrangements facilitated by the Ritz-Carlton Yacht Collection ("**Carrier**"). In the event of a conflict between these terms and the general Booking Terms and Conditions, these terms shall prevail regarding Air Services.

### 1. Nature of Services

Carrier facilitates air arrangements as a convenience to Guests from select US gateways. Carrier does not own, operate, or control any airline. All air travel is subject to the terms, conditions, and Tariffs of the transporting air carrier. Carrier's liability and responsibility are limited to the Vessel and do not extend to the air travel component.

### 2. Air Product Categories

Carrier offers two distinct air products. Guests are responsible for verifying which product they have selected at the time of booking:

- **Pre-Designed Air:** A curated, round-trip itinerary designed to align with the Cruise schedule.
  - **Price Guarantee:** Flight pricing is finalized and guaranteed upon completion of the Pre-Designed Air booking process.
  - **Availability:** Subject to airline inventory and select gateway participation.
- **Custom Air:** Individualized itineraries for non-standard gateways, one-way travel, or specific date deviations.
  - **Price Guarantee:** Pricing and schedules are not guaranteed until the itinerary is accepted by the Guest and paid in full. Custom Air is subject to live market volatility until ticketed.

### 3. Ticketing and Guest Requirements

- **Documentation:** Airline tickets will not be issued until Carrier receives full payment and all required Guest data (Legal Name as it appears on Passport, Passport Number/Expiry, Gender, DOB, and Nationality).
- **Data Accuracy:** Discrepancies reported after ticket issuance may result in the forfeiture of the original fare. Guest is responsible for all costs associated with replacement tickets.
- **Identity of Carrier:** Airline identity (including code-share partners) will be disclosed at the time of confirmation.

### 4. Cancellations

<b>Custom Air: Modification</b>	Subject to live market pricing, airline fees, and the Aviation Facilitation Fee.	Subject to live market pricing, airline fees, and the Aviation Facilitation Fee.

**Aviation Facilitation Fee:** A non-refundable, non-transferable service fee of **\$150 USD / €150 EUR / £100 GBP / \$230 AUD** per guest. This fee applies to all voluntary modifications and pre-90-day cancellations.

**Aviation Regulations:** All air tickets, once issued, are governed by the specific regulations, Tariffs, and fare conditions of the transporting air carrier. Guests are responsible for any airline-imposed fare differences or change penalties.

**Custom Air Volatility:** Because Custom Air involves individualized itineraries, pricing and schedules are not guaranteed until the itinerary is accepted by the Guest and paid in full.

## 5. Changes and Restrictions

- **Name Changes:** Generally prohibited. If permitted by the airline, the Guest is responsible for all airline fees and fare differences.
- **Ancillaries:** Unless expressly included in the Guest's specific fare class or itinerary, airfares do not include ancillary services, including but not limited to: advanced seat assignments, checked baggage fees, in-flight Wi-Fi, or meal service. All such costs are the sole responsibility of the Guest.

### **Linkage of Air and Cruise Bookings:**

Air arrangements are facilitated exclusively as an adjunct to a confirmed Cruise booking. Accordingly, the cancellation of a Cruise booking for any reason shall result in the automatic and simultaneous cancellation of all associated air arrangements.

- **Guest-Initiated Cancellation:** If the Guest cancels the Cruise, air-related refunds are governed by the cancellation schedule set forth herein.
  - More than 90 Days: Cancellations are subject to the standard Cruise cancellation fees plus a non-refundable Aviation Facilitation Fee.
  - 90 Days or Fewer: Cancellations will result in a 100% forfeiture of the Air Fare.
- **Carrier-Initiated Cancellation:** If the Cruise is cancelled by the Carrier, airfare refunds or credits will be processed in accordance with applicable consumer protection laws.

**Ticketing Limitation:** Under no circumstances will Carrier be obligated to issue or "ticket" air travel for a voyage that has been cancelled, regardless of whether Cruise cancellation penalties were applied.
